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**DIRECTOR'S ORDER UNDER SECTION 157 OF THE FAIR TRADING ACT**

**Issues:**

Michel-Anthony Bastille registered his company, No NonSense Renovations Ltd in September 2006. In January 2008, he entered into prepaid contracts with two consumers. As a result of these contracts, down payments and progress payments were accepted.

This activity constitutes a "Prepaid Contracting Business" requiring Michel-Anthony Bastille and/or No NonSense Renovations Ltd to be licensed as required under section 104(1) of the *Fair Trading Act*.

At the time of entering into the prepaid contract with the consumers, Michel-Anthony Bastille and/or No NonSense Renovations Ltd was not licensed as a Prepaid Contracting Business as required under section 104(1) of the *Fair Trading Act*.

A "Prepaid Contracting Business" means the activities of soliciting, negotiating, or concluding in person at any time other than at the seller's place of business, a prepaid contract.

A "Prepaid Contract" means a construction or maintenance contract in which all or part of the contract price is to be paid before all of the goods or services called for in the contract are provided.

A stylized, handwritten-style signature of the word "Alberta" in a cursive font.

A "Construction or Maintenance Contract" in part means a contract for the purpose of constructing, altering, maintaining, repairing, adding to, or improving a person's own private dwelling or a structure/building located on the same property, used in connection with a person's own private dwelling or improving real property to be used in connection with the person's own private dwelling/building/structure.

**ORDER:**

- Michel-Anthony Bastille individually or through any employee, representative, agent or associate must immediately stop engaging in the activities of a "Prepaid Contracting Business" by soliciting, negotiating, or concluding in person, at any place other than the seller's place of business, a prepaid contract.
- No NonSense Renovations Ltd, through any employee, representative, agent, or associate, must immediately stop engaging in the activities of a "Prepaid Contracting Business" by soliciting, negotiating or concluding in person, at any place other than the seller's place of business, a prepaid contract.

**NON COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER:**

**ANY PERSON WHO FAILS TO COMPLY WITH AN ORDER OF THE DIRECTOR UNDER SECTION 157 OF THE *FAIR TRADING ACT* CONTRAVENES THIS ACT AND IS GUILTY OF AN OFFENCE AND MAY BE PROSECUTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 163 OF THE *FAIR TRADING ACT*.**
