



Personal Information Protection Act (PIPA)

As of January 1, 2004, businesses need to ask Albertans for consent when collecting their personal information. Albertans must also be told how their personal information will be used and disclosed.

Under the Personal Information Protection Act (PIPA), businesses must also limit the information they collect to only what is needed for specific transactions with customers and employees.

Information protected by PIPA includes any personal information that identifies an individual, such as:

- Name, address, age, gender, weight and height
- Employment or financial history
- ID numbers, place of birth, ethnic origin
- Opinions, evaluations or comments about an individual.
